

**WALTER O. MASON EDUCATION FOUNDATION &  
MATTHEW W. TAYLOR SCHOLARSHIP 2023 COMPETITION**

**Selection Criteria & Eligibility:**

1. Applicant must be a 2022-2023 currently enrolled high school senior or college student.
2. Applicant must have a 2023-2024 completed FAFSA submitted.
3. Applicant must demonstrate extracurricular and community involvement.
4. Applicant must be a TRIO participant with active participation for *at least one year*.
5. If selected, applicant must provide proof of enrollment at a postsecondary institution for the fall 2023 semester.

**Guidelines:**

1. Each program may submit a maximum of two applications and shall establish its own criteria for determining which two applications are forwarded to the scholarship committee. Please note students will need to submit each requested document below as a separate pdf file. Program Director's are responsible for collecting and reviewing the applications to select the two they wish to be considered for the scholarship competition.
2. Applications (maximum of two) recommended by the Program Director must be submitted by the student with the assistance of the Program Director via the AwardSpring scholarship portal (<https://txtrio.awardspring.com/>) by March 31, 2023. The Program Director will need to assist the student in registering an account with the AwardSpring scholarship portal from the link above to submit scholarship documents from the application checklist below. The student will create an account with their email address and upload each document in pdf format (7 total documents).
3. The Texas TRIO Association Scholarship Committee will review and rank all submitted applications. The highest-ranking application will be awarded the Walter O. Mason Scholarship funded by the Walter O'Mason Foundation. Other deserving applications (in subsequent order) will receive the Matthew W. Taylor scholarship funded by Texas TRIO Association. The number of Matthew W. Taylor scholarships winners will be determined by the Texas TRIO Association board.
4. The Scholarship Committee will submit the application rankings to the Texas TRIO Association Board. The Scholarship Chairs will contact the TRIO Directors and Scholarship Recipients in May 2023.
5. Program Director/staff who recommended scholarships must be a Texas TRIO Association member in good standing.

**Personal Statement Topic and Format:**

- Write a personal statement explaining how TRIO has changed your life and how TRIO is preparing you or has prepared you to reach your future goals.

- Format: Typed, one-inch margins, double spaced with a 12pt font, Times New Roman. Include applicant's name, TRIO project, and institution as a header or a title on each page. Minimum of one page; maximum of two pages double spaced.

### **Writing Tips for Personal Statement:**

- Writing should demonstrate a logical arrangement of information: effective transition and a flow of general ideas to specific conclusions.
- Writing should demonstrate an understanding of the addressed subject and use effective supporting statements - relevant details and/or examples.
- Writing should illustrate the applicant's insight, creativity, thoughtfulness or originality expressed in his/her own words.
- Writing should incorporate active voice where appropriate and have an insignificant number of grammatical, punctuation, and spelling errors.
